Join a live question and answer session to learn about Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA), Temporary Protected Status (TPS), and other programs that may be available to immigrants not yet in deportation proceedings. Emphasis will be placed on family-based and humanitarian immigration relief, including visa programs for victims of violence in their home country and work permit eligibility.

Ask your questions about:

- Options available to undocumented immigrants seeking to remain in the U.S.
- Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals (DACA): How the program works, and its current status after court challenges
- Temporary Protected Status (TPS) for victims of armed conflict and natural disasters
- Other family-based and humanitarian immigration relief.
- Resources available in the Los Angeles area to help with immigration issues
- Work permit eligibility and avoiding fraud
- Traveling on Advanced Parole
